**POSITION:**

Storm Water and Wastewater Compliance Specialist position (Research Associate II Special) available with the Center for Environmental Management of Military Lands, to be assigned at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii (Island of Oahu) to provide support to the US Army Garrison, Hawaii Environmental Division. Position is contingent on availability of funding.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

BS/BA in environmental management, chemistry, engineering, environmental science, public health or closely related field. Must have work experience in Storm Water and Wastewater compliance and/or permitting. Work experience conducting water quality sampling in accordance with State and Federal guidance. Must have proficient computer skills including ability to use Microsoft programs and databases. Must be physically able to carry out organized fieldwork that may include bending, lifting (at least 25 lbs), ladder climbing, and climbing steep to very steep slopes to access sampling sites. Must have or be able to obtain a valid Hawaii driver's license.

**DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:**

MS/MA degree. Knowledge of established principles, concepts, and methods involving Clean Water Act regulations. Knowledge of policies and procedures of Federal, State, and local agencies related to Storm Water and Wastewater compliance. Knowledge principles and concepts needed for sampling protocol development, storm water quality assessment, and database design. Skill in using standard data gathering analysis techniques to identify and solve problems. Experience working in highly structured organizations, such as governmental agencies, the military or corporations, with established lines of authority, procedures, and protocols. Excellent written and oral communication skills.

**BACKGROUND CHECK:**

Colorado State University is committed to providing a safe and productive learning and living community. **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The applicant will assist in the development and implementation of a Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP) and with wastewater compliance on US Army Garrison – Hawaii installations. Work will include updating or creating a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for each facility; performing storm water discharge reviews and providing recommendations for further work; providing Geographic Information System (GIS) data for public education/outreach program; reviewing the existing Storm water system and making recommendations for the maintenance of the system. In addition the work will involve wastewater compliance inspection. This will include reviewing the services provided to the Army to determine compliance with existing permits, and will include renewal of expiring industrial wastewater discharge permits and collection of water quality samples for testing.

**SALARY:** Commensurate with experience and qualifications. Range \$45,000-52,000
